Sec. 22-56. - Membership; appointment; terms.

A total of eight people shall serve on the library advisory board with staggered terms. All eight people will serve two-year terms. One councilmember shall serve as an ex-officio member of the total eight members of the library advisory board with a two-year term or as appointed by the council. No member can serve more than two consecutive terms. The library advisory board members are to be appointed by the town council.

Sec. 22-57. - Vacancies.

Should any vacancy occur among the members of the library advisory board by reason of expired term, registration, dismissal or other reason, a letter of registration or other notice should be submitted to the mayor by the secretary through the town manager. Should any vacancies occur, the mayor will receive letters of recommendation from the library advisory board. The vacancy shall be filled in accordance with section 22-56.

Sec. 22-58. - Rules and regulations.

- (a) The library advisory board is hereby authorized to adopt, repeal and amend, from time to time, rules and regulations governing the operation of the library not in conflict with this article or any applicable state statute as it is adopted or may from time to time be amended or repealed.
- (b) Included in the authority delegated to the library advisory board is the authority to establish rules and periods for which materials may be checked out and the return thereof; renewal of checked-out materials; requirements of the issuance and revocation of library cards; charges for failure to return materials when due; and retention and/or disposal of materials.
- (c) Advise the town council, town manager, and library director concerning all matters relating to the operation of a public library system for the town.
- (d) Work cooperatively with the Friends of the Library in support of the library.
- (e) Advise the council on the extension of privileges to and use of the library by nonresidents of the library's service area and any fees associated therewith.
- (f) The library advisory board may delegate such authority given to it in this section as it deems necessary and reasonable to the librarian of the Harold D. Cooley Library.
